

Asus Z54C-JS31 Display Replacement

This guide will show how to replace the display of an Asus Z54C-JS31 laptop.

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INTRODUCTION

The display is vital to using a laptop. If the display is damaged or not functioning properly this guide will show how to replace it.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Battery







- Turn the laptop upside down so that the underside is facing up and locate the two switches that are on each side of the battery.
- Slide the switch on the top right corner to the right.
- Slide and hold the switch on the top left corner to the left and carefully remove the battery.

Step 2 — Display









- Open up the laptop and locate the two circular stickers at the bottom corners of the display.
- Use a pair of tweezers to remove the two black stickers covering the screws.
- Using a Philips #000 screwdriver, remove the two 9mm screws.

Step 3




Use the plastic opening tool to pop off the plastic border around the display.

Step 4



- Remove the two 9mm screws from the top corners of the display with a Phillips #000 screwdriver.
- Carefully lift the display out and place the screen face down on the keyboard.

Step 5



 Disconnect the display cable connector attached to the display.
