INTRODUCTION

A cracked door frame can often deteriorate in time but can be salvaged when fixed with a repair kit. This guide will help homeowners repair cracks in the door frame on their own and at a very low cost, without having to replace the entire door frame.



TOOLS:

- Large Clamp (1)
- Precision Drill Bits (1)
- Cordless Drill (1)
- Wood Filler (1)
- Paint (1)
- Paintbrush (1)
- 150 Grit Sandpaper (1)
- Chisel Scraper (1)

Step 1 — How to Fix Cracked Door Jamb



 Cracked door jamb/frame caused by excessive force on door.

Step 2



 Apply wood filler into the cracks of the door frame.

Step 3





- Attach the clamp onto the cracked door frame.
- (i) Use a clamp with rubber edges for a sturdier grip and also to prevent damaging the door frame.

Step 4





- Drill a pilot hole into the door frame.
- Screw a 4-inch screw into the frame through the pilot hole.

Step 5



- Wait for the wood filler to dry.
- Once dried, scrape off the excess filler with a scraper.

Step 6



Sand the filled up cracks to get a smooth surface.

Step 7



Paint and do not touch until dry.

Step 8



Repaired door frame/ door jamb.
