

#### Step 1 — Loosen the Screws




- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer and follow the steps in Before Working Inside Your Computer. After working inside your computer, follow the instructions in After Working Inside Your Computer.
- Loosen the five captive screws that secure the base cover to the computer base.

#### Step 2 — Pry the Base Cover



 Using a plastic scribe, gently pry the base cover to release the tabs on the base cover from the slots on the computer base.

# Step 3 — Lift the Base Cover



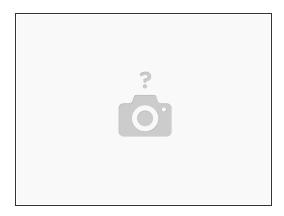
 Lift the base cover off the computer base.

# **Step 4** — **Disconnect the Battery Cable**




 Using a plastic scribe, disconnect the battery cable from the system board.

# **Step 5** — **Press and Hold the Power-Button**



Press and hold the power button for five seconds to ground the system board.

# Step 6 — Connect the Battery Cable




Connect the battery cable to the system board.

#### Step 7 — Slide the Tabs



 Slide the tabs on the NEW base cover into the slots on the computer base and snap the base cover into place

#### Step 8 — Tighten the Five Captive Screws



 Tighten the five captive screws that secure the base cover to the computer base.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
