


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove the mSATA card.


Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Removing the Battery



- Disconnect the battery cable from the system board.
 - Remove the screws that secure the battery to the palm-rest assembly.
 - Lift the battery, along with its cable, off the palm-rest assembly.
- i Turn the computer over, open the display, and press the power button for about five seconds to ground the system board.
- If this is all you are doing Follow Step In Reverse if not Go to Next Step.

Step 2 — Removing the mSATA card



- Remove the screw that secures the mSATA card to the palm-rest assembly.
 - Slide the mSATA card out of the mSATA-card connector.
- If this is all you are doing Follow Step In Reverse if not Go to Next Step.
