

# Canon PowerShot SD1400 IS User Interface Panel Replacement

Replace your broken or unresponsive button panel in order to use the Canon PowerShot SD1400 IS.

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#### **INTRODUCTION**

The buttons on the user interface panel can become broken or stuck. This guide will show how to replace the user interface panel on the Canon PowerShot SD1400 IS.

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- 64 Bit Driver Kit (1)

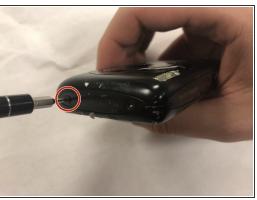


## **PARTS:**

## **Step 1 — User Interface Panel**







Remove the four 2.0 mm Phillips screws of the camera using the J00 bit from the 54-bit Driver Kit.
 There are two screws on both sides.

#### Step 2



 Remove the 4.0 mm Phillips screw located on the bottom of the camera.

## Step 3



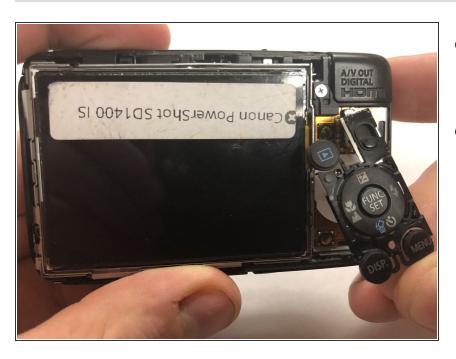
- Remove the front face panel of the camera by hand using firm pressure.
- If one point of the face is stuck to the body, check if there is a screw preventing the front face from coming off.

## Step 4



 Remove the rear panel of the camera by hand using firm pressure.

# Step 5



- Remove the user interface panel by hand. The panel may fall out on its own, this is normal.
- Replace the user interface panel by setting it in position.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
