

INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will show you how to remove and replace the Memory Module.



TOOLS:

• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Releasing the Battery



 Slide the battery latches to release the battery.

Step 2 — Removing the Battery




 Lift and remove the battery from the computer.

Step 3 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the screw(s) that secures the cover to the computer. Lift the cover upwards.

Step 4 — Sliding the Cover




 Slide the cover outwards to release it from the notches on the computer.

Step 5 — Lifiting the Cover



 Lift the cover upwards and away from the computer.

Step 6 — Removing the Memory Module



 Pry the retention clips away from the memory module until it pops-up. Lift and remove the memory module from its connector.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
