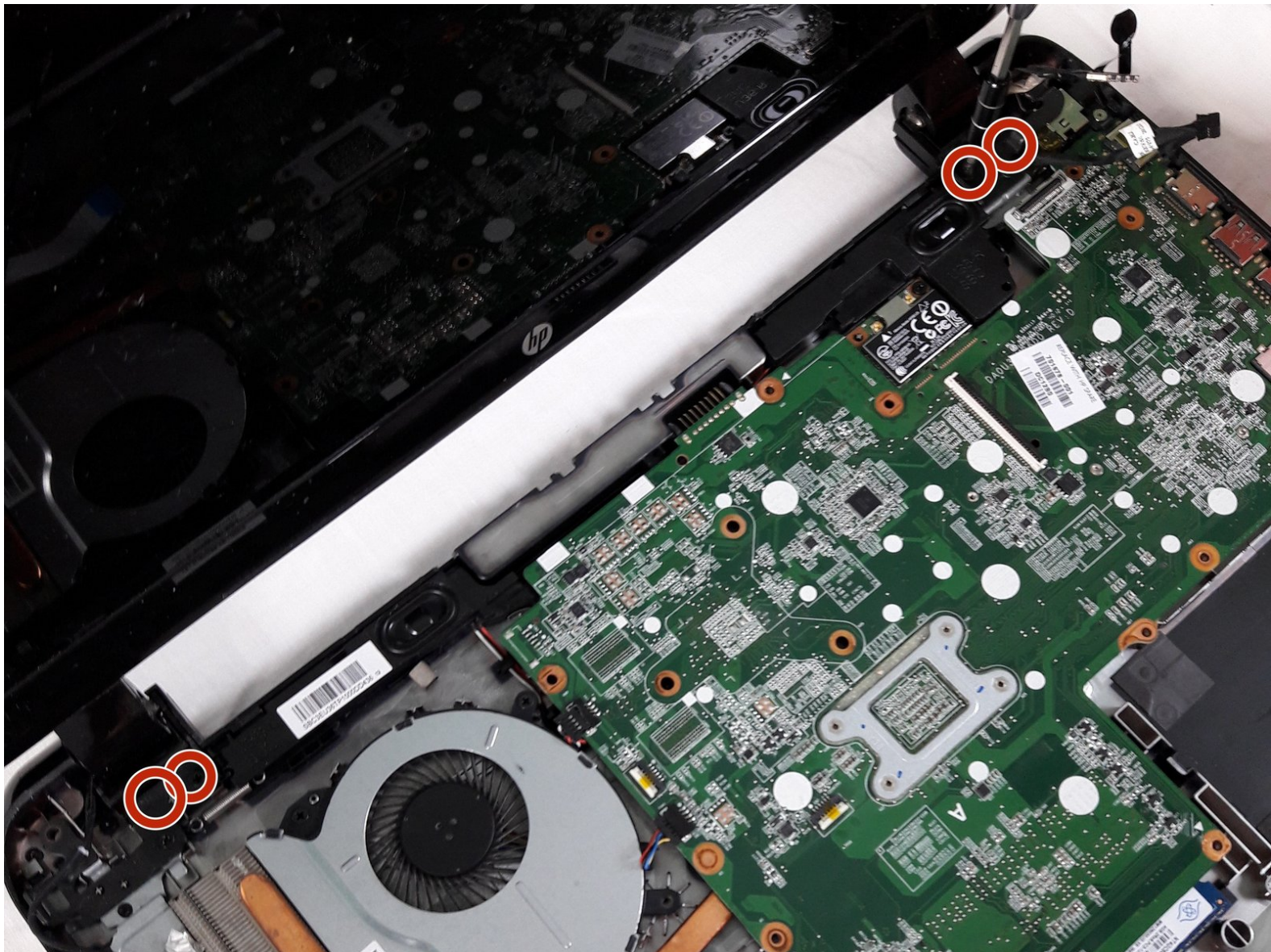




HP Pavilion Sleekbook 15-b000 Screen Replacement

Remove the Screen for future repairs or replace the Screen if damaged.

INTRODUCTION

This guide will go through the steps to replace the screen if it is not displaying anything or the display is distorted.



TOOLS:

- [Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)
 - [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Unplug laptop from adapter and all other devices.

Step 2



- Flip the laptop over with battery facing you.

Step 3



- Slide the battery lock on the right side open.
- Slide the Battery release latch on the left side.

Step 4



- Pull battery out.

Step 5 — Keyboard



- Remove the two 6.5mm Phillips #1 keyboard screws from bottom of laptop.

Step 6



- Push screwdriver through screw hole top pop the keyboard.
- ⓘ Make sure the screen is open.

Step 7



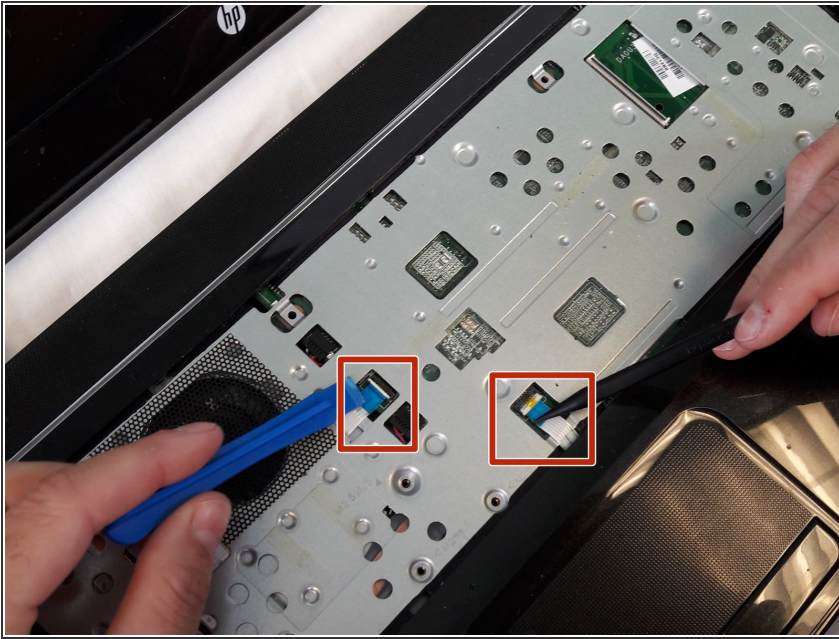
- Pry up the keyboard.
- ⓘ The keyboard is still attached by it's ribbon.

Step 8



- Remove keyboard wire by popping latch under blue plastic

Step 9 — Case



- Using the spudger to lift up on the white tabs
- Pull horizontally on the blue ribbon to disconnect the cables

Step 10



- Remove the five 5.5mm Phillips #1 screws from the case

Step 11



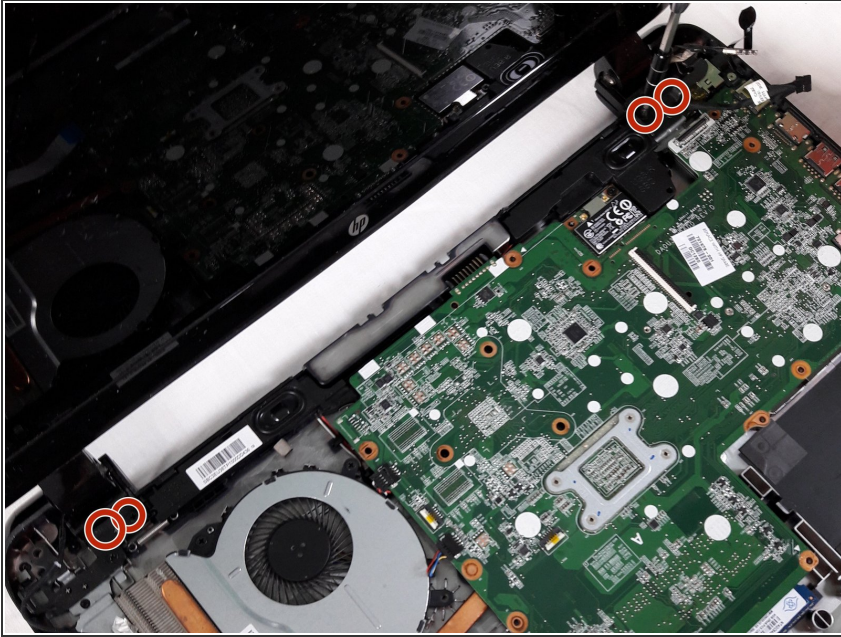
- Remove eight 6.5mm Phillips #1 screws from the back cover

Step 12



- Starting at a top corner, use the pry tool to split the case.
- Slowly work around the case, pulling up gently to release the clips.

Step 13 — Screen



- Remove the four 5.5mm Phillips #1 screws attaching the screen.

Step 14



- Remove the two 3.5mm Phillips #1 screws from the bottom of the screen.

Step 15



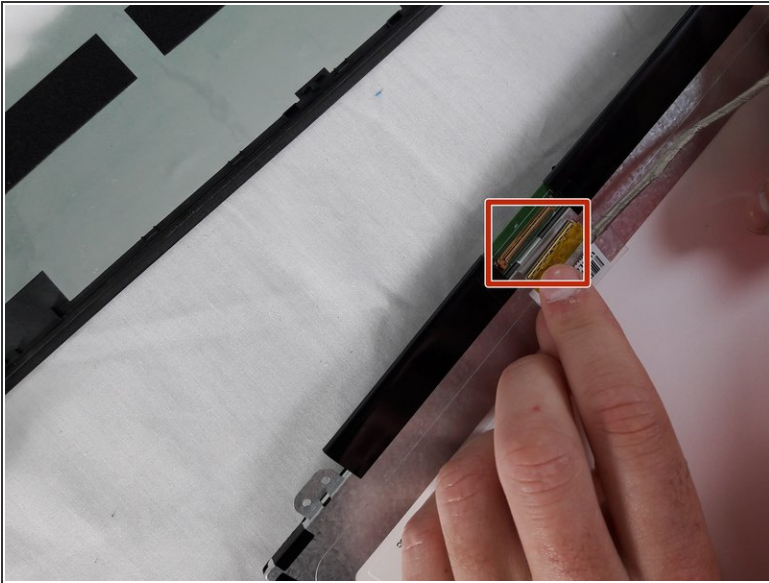
- Remove the screen from it's case.
- ❗ Screen is still connected to it's case by a wire.

Step 16



- Lay the screen face down on a surface where it ill not scratch

Step 17



- Lift up plastic over latch for the screen.
- Pull the connector away from the screen to disconnect it.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
