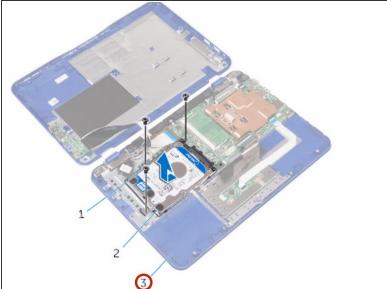
Step 1 — Remove the Screws

 - Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

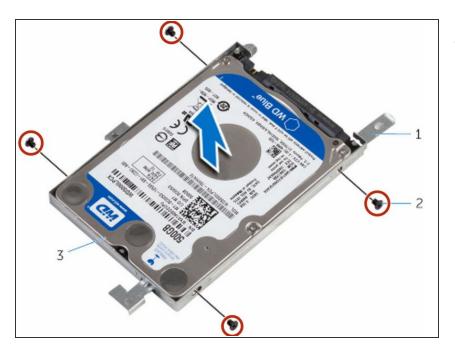
Step 2 — Slide and Lift the Hard-Drive





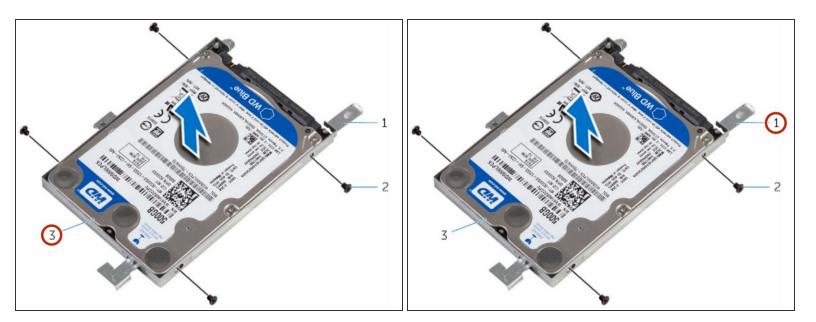
• Slide and lift the hard-drive assembly off the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

Step 3 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 4 — Lifting the Hard Drive



• Lift the hard drive from the hard-drive bracket.

Step 5 — Align the Screw Holes



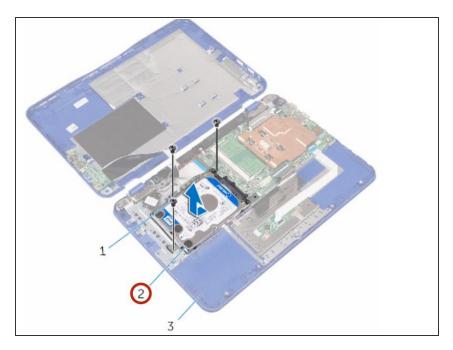
 Align the screw holes on the hard drive with the screw holes on the hard-drive bracket.

Step 6 — Replace the Screws



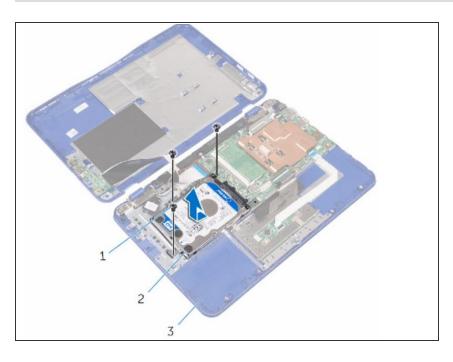
 Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 7 — Connecting the Hard Drive



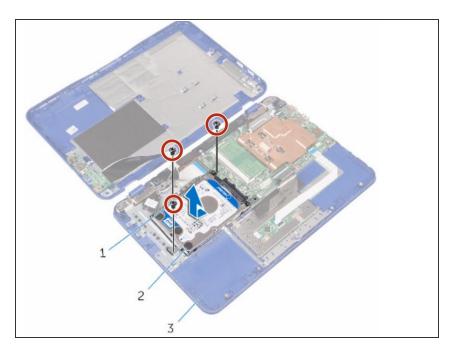
 Slide and connect the hard-drive assembly to the connector on the system board.

Step 8 — Align the Screw Holes



 Align the screw holes on the harddrive assembly with the screw holes on the palm rest and keyboard assembly

Step 9 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.
