


TOOLS:

Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- (i) Make certain that the power to your laptop is off.
- Press and slide the two buttons outwards and away from the battery.

Step 2




 Slide the battery away and parallel from the laptop.

Step 3



Remove the battery from the slot.

Step 4 — Back Panel





• Unscrew the eight 6mm screws with a Philips #1 screw driver.

Step 5



 Lift back cover from the groove on the left side of the cover next to the symbol.

Step 6 — Wi-Fi Card





• Remove the two 3mm Philips #1 screws from the top of the Wi-Fi card.

Step 7





Unclip both black and white wires from the Wi-Fi card.

Step 8



 Gently pull Wi-Fi card out of its position at its angle.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
