

INTRODUCTION


How to remove and replace the Hard-Drive.



TOOLS:


Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Removing the Screws




 Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.

Step 2 — **Disconnecting the Hard-Drive Cable**




 Open the latch and disconnect the hard-drive cable from the system board.

Step 3 — Lifting the Hard-Drive




 Lift the hard-drive assembly off the computer base.

Step 4 — Removing the Screws




 Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 5 — Lifting the Hard-Drive Bracket




 Lift the hard-drive bracket off the hard drive.

Step 6 — **Disconnecting the Interposer**




 Disconnect the interposer from the hard drive.

Step 7 — Connecting the Interposer




 Connect the interposer to the NEW hard drive.

Step 8 — Align the Screws




 Align the screw holes on the harddrive bracket with the screw holes on the hard drive.

Step 9 — Securing the Screws




 Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 10 — Align the Screw Holes




 Align the screw holes on the harddrive assembly with the screw holes on the computer base.

Step 11 — Securing the Screws



 Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.

Step 12 — Sliding the Hard-Drive Cable



 Slide the hard-drive cable into the system board and close the latch to secure the cable.
