


## MacBook Air 13" Mid 2012 Lower Case Replacement

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## INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace a damaged lower case.

<ul> <li>FOOLS:</li> <li>P5 Pentalobe Screwdriver Retina MacBook Pro and Air (1)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>PARTS:</li> <li>MacBook Air 13" (Mid 2012) Lower Case (1)</li> <li>MacBook Air 13" Late 2010 to 2017 Lower Case Screw Set (1)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>MacBook Air Rubber Feet (1)</li> </ul>

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## Step 1 — Lower Case



- (i) Before proceeding, power down your MacBook. Close the display and lay it on a soft surface, top-side down.
  - Use a <u>P5 Pentalobe</u> driver to remove ten screws securing the lower case, of the following lengths:
    - Two 9 mm screws
    - Eight 2.6 mm screws

## Step 2



- Wedge your fingers between the display and the lower case and pull upward to pop the lower case off the Air.
- Remove the lower case and set it aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

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
