

LG Optimus F60 Screen Replacement

Replace your broken phone screen to be able to operate your device again.

INTRODUCTION

This guide will take you through the process of replacing the screen in an LG Optimus F60. This task should take about 6 minutes to complete.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Battery







- Hold the phone in your hand and position the small plastic opening tool or your finger under the lip
 of the phone by the USB port.
- Pry or lift up on the indent with the opening tool.
- Remove the back panel.

Step 2








- Place the small plastic opening tool or your finger at the indentation at the base of the battery.
- Pry upwards or lift with your finger and remove battery.

Step 3 — Screen




 Remove the eight 4 mm screws on the inner panel using the phillips #000 Screwdriver

Step 4



Remove bottom of inner panel.

Step 5








- Remove inner panel using plastic opening tool.
- (i) Apply force upwards while wiggling the tool further in.

Step 6







Unlatch Connector on bottom left of phone.

Step 7





Pull motherboard to detach digitizer from the motherboard
