




Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Remove the Screws





- Remove the screws that secure the battery bracket to the system board and palm rest and keyboard assembly.

#### Step 2 — Removing the Battery Bracket




• Lift and remove the battery bracket.

#### Step 3 — Remove the Screw




- Remove the screw that secures the battery to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.
- i NOTE: Note the location of the screw that secures the battery to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

#### Step 4 — Lifting the Battery




 Lift the battery off the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

#### **Step 5** — **Align the Screw Holes**




 Align the screw holes on the NEW battery with the screw holes on the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

#### Step 6 — Replace the Screw




 Replace the screw that secures the battery to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

### Step 7 — Align the Screw Holes



 Align the screw holes on the battery bracket with the screw holes on the system board and palm rest and keyboard assembly.
