


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Display Assembly.

TOOLS:

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• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove the Screws



- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in <u>Before You Begin.</u>
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
 - Turn the computer over and remove the two screws.

Step 2 — Disconnect the Antenna Cables




 Disconnect the Mini-Card antenna cables from the Mini-Card.

Step 3 — Disconnect the Display Cable



 Disconnect the display cable from the connector on the system board and remove it from the routing guide.

Step 4 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the four screws (two on each side) that secure the display assembly to the computer base.

Step 5 — Removing the Display Assembly



 Lift and remove the display assembly out of the computer base.

Step 6 — Placing the Display Assembly



Place the NEW display assembly in position and replace the four screws (two on each side) that secure the display assembly to the computer base.

Step 7 — Routing the Display Cable




 Route the display cable into the routing guide and connect the cable to the connector on the system board.

Step 8 — Connect the Antenna Cables



 Connect the Mini-Card antenna cables to the connectors on the Mini- Card.

Step 9 — Replace the Screws



• Turn the computer over and replace the two screws at the bottom of the computer.
