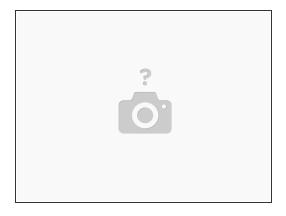
In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive.

### Step 1 — CAUTION



- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in "Before You Begin".
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- ↑ CAUTION: Hard drives are extremely fragile. Exercise care when handling the hard drive.

# Step 2 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the two screws from the computer base.

# **Step 3** — **Sliding the Hard Drive**




 Slide the hard drive to the right to disconnect it from the connector on the system board.

# Step 4 — Lifting the Hard Drive




 Lift the hard drive out of the computer base.

# **Step 5** — Placing the Hard Drive



 Place the **NEW** hard drive on the computer base.

# Step 6 — Push the Hard Drive



 Push the hard drive towards the left to connect it to the connector on the system board.

# **Step 7** — Replace the Screws



 Replace the two screws to the computer base.
