

Asus Zenfone 3 Max Battery Replacement

INTRODUCTION

If your Asus Zenfone 3 Max phone fails to charge, it could be due to a malfunctioning or damaged device battery. This guide will help you remove your phone battery and replace it with a new one. Before you begin, please note that the replacement of battery must be done with great care, as you can potentially damage other parts of the device. PARTS:

Step 1 — Back cover





- Using an iFixit opening tool, gently wedge the tool between the phone and the back casing.
- Move the opening tool up and down to pry the back off of the device.

Step 2



Once the original cover has been removed, apply the new cover to the back of the phone with careful pressure.

Step 3 — Battery








- Gently disconnect the gold connection cable indicated by the red circle in the corresponding picture.
- Pull back on the black adhesive tab that is adhered to the top of the battery. Tab removal is marked in the corresponding picture with a orange circle.
- Once the gold connection cable and black adhesive tab are no longer connected to the battery, the battery can be removed.

Step 4







- Next, remove the battery by gently pulling on the blue removal tab located at the bottom of the device battery.
- Completely remove existing device battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
