#### **PARTS:**


- Crucial MX500 1 TB SSD (1)
- Crucial MX500 250 GB SSD (1)
- Crucial MX500 500 GB SSD (1)
- Crucial MX500 2 TB SSD (1)

#### Step 1 — Battery



Flip the computer over so that the bottom panel is facing you.

## Step 2





Slide the switches away from each other to release the battery.

## Step 3





Using your hands, gently remove the battery from the device.

#### Step 4 — Hard Drive





Using a Phillips #00 screwdriver, unscrew the two screws.


## Step 5





Gently remove the hard drive.

## Step 6



 Undo the Phillips #1 screw keeping the drive in the bracket.

## Step 7



Remove the drive from the bracket,
