Step 1 — Battery



- Flip the computer over so that the bottom panel is facing you.

Step 2



- Slide the switches away from each other to release the battery.

Step 3



- Using your hands, gently remove the battery from the device.

Step 4 — Hard Drive



- Using a Phillips #00 screwdriver, unscrew the two screws.

Step 5



- Gently remove the hard drive.

Step 6



- Undo the Phillips #1 screw keeping the drive in the bracket.

Step 7



- Remove the drive from the bracket,
