



Google Pixel 4 SIM Card Tray Replacement

Guide to eject and remove the SIM card tray in the Google Pixel 4.

Use this guide to eject and remove or replace the SIM card tray on your Google Pixel 4.

TOOLS:

- [SIM Card Eject Tool](#) (1)
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Step 1 — Remove the SIM card tray



- Insert a SIM eject tool, bit, or a straightened paper clip into the small hole on the SIM card tray on the left edge of the phone.
- Press firmly to eject the tray.
- Remove the SIM card tray.

Compare your new replacement part to the original part—you may need to transfer remaining components or remove adhesive backings from the new part before installing.

To reassemble your device, follow the above steps in reverse order.
