INTRODUCTION

This is quick and easy guide on how to replace a key fob battery of a 2014 Toyota Corolla. Rather than trying to find someone to do it for you, you can do it at home in under 5 minutes.



Step 1 — Key Fob Battery







- Open the back cover of the key fob with a flat prying tool.
- (i) In the photo I have used the back of tweezers.

Step 2







Remove the remote from the key fob.

Step 3






- Grab the remote and grip where the edges meet.
- Pull on the two covers until they come off.


Step 4





Lift the battery out using a prying tool.

Step 5





Remove the battery from the key fob.

Step 6



 Insert the new battery into the bracket.
