




# Wahl Lithium Ion Trimmer Electric Motor Replacement





## Step 1 — Electric Motor



- Refer to the 4th step in disassemble process to begin replacement of motor.

## Step 2




- Remove the chip set, battery and motor as one piece.

### Step 3



- In this step focus on the motor, ignoring the chip set and battery. Here you will be able to remove the motor from the wires.

### Step 4



- After the wires are removed and the motor is detached use the replacement motor you purchased and reconnect the wires.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
