## INTRODUCTION

An easy guide for replacing letter keys



#### Step 1 — Letter Key



- Open the laptop on a flat stable surface.
- Using tweezers, grab the desired key on its right side and pull up towards the left.

## Step 2



 Insert key holder by pressing down with tweezers until a pop is heard

## Step 3



 Once holder is in, place new key over holder and press down, until a click is heard.

If the letter key does not click back into place, remove and place back on to retry.
