INTRODUCTION

This guide details how to replace the flash bulb of this camera.

TOOLS:

Tweezers (1)
Flush Cutter (1)
Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery




- Locate the battery cover at the bottom of the camera.
- Pull down on the black tab to open the cover.

Step 2



- Push the grey tab on the right side of the battery.
- Remove the battery from the slot.

Step 3 — Flash



 Using the Phillips screwdriver, unscrew the two 4.9mm
 Phillips head screws which are located underneath the flash.

Step 4




• Remove the covering.

Step 5



 Use the <u>tweezers</u> to remove the excess glue around the wiring. This will allow you to cut the wire and remove the light in the next step.

Step 6



 Use the wire cutters to cut the wiring connected to the flash.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
