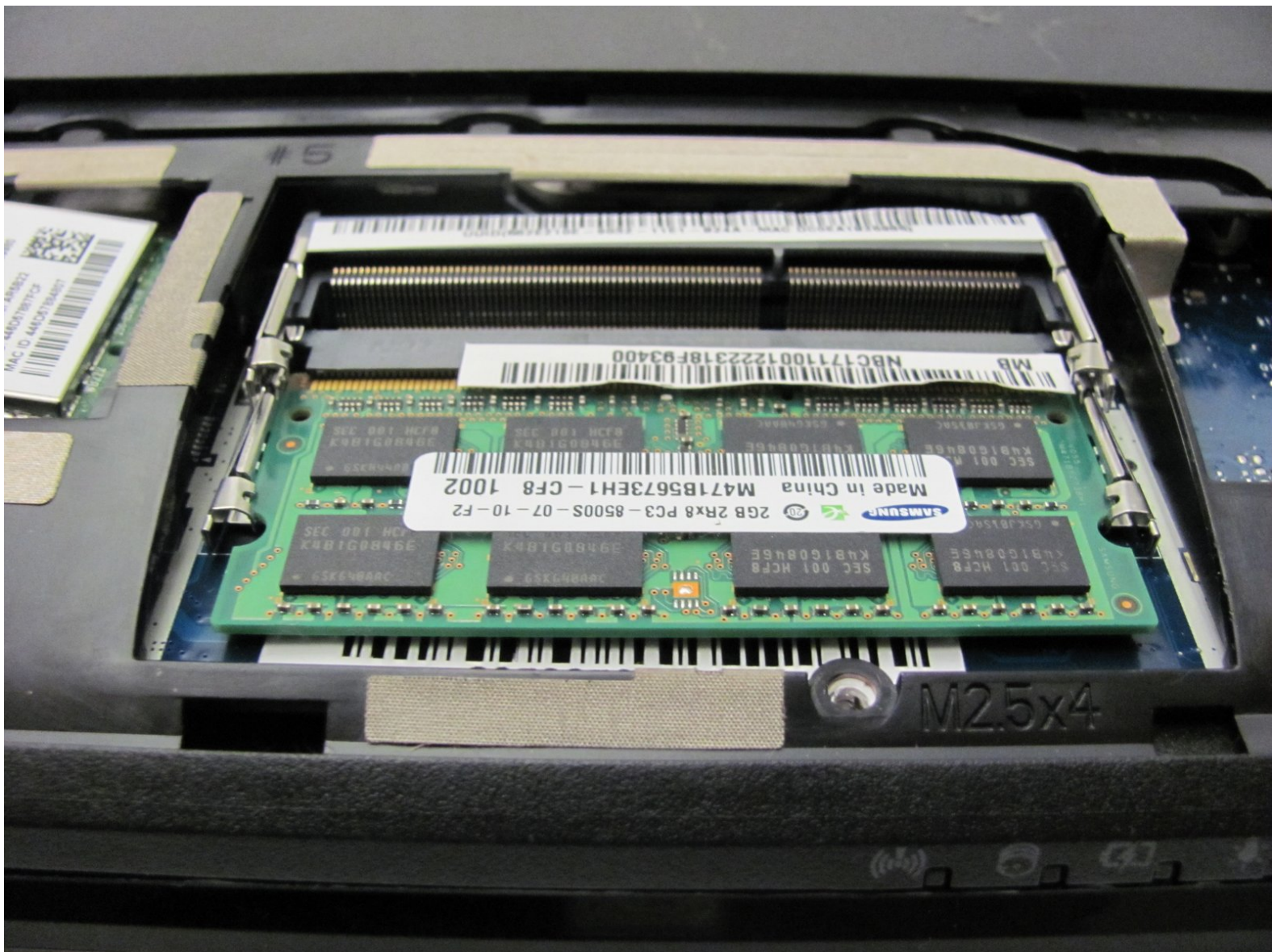

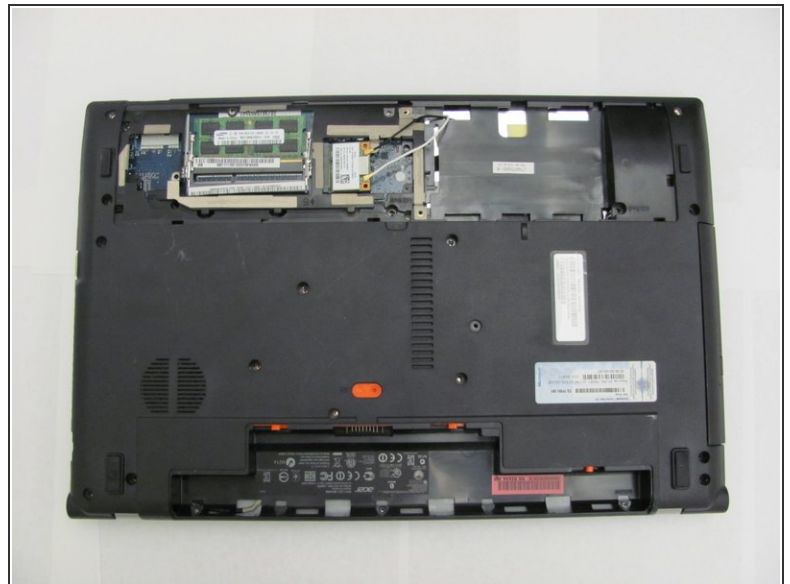
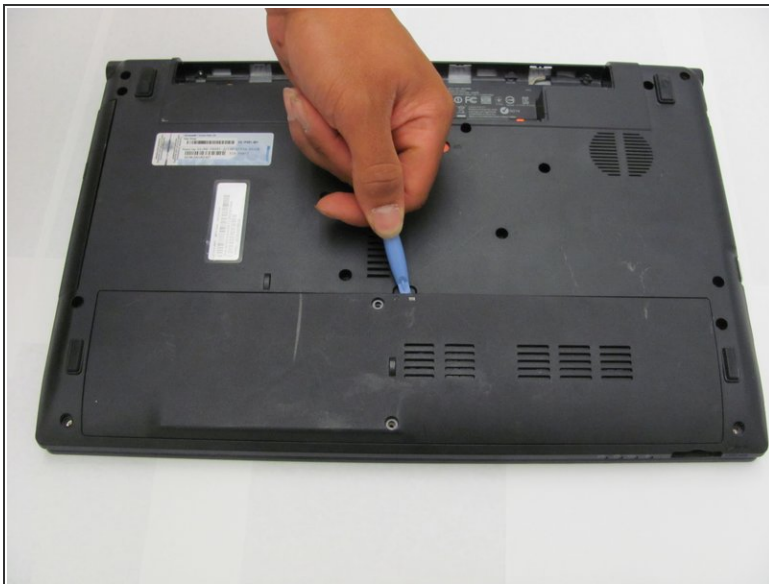

Step 1 — Back Panel



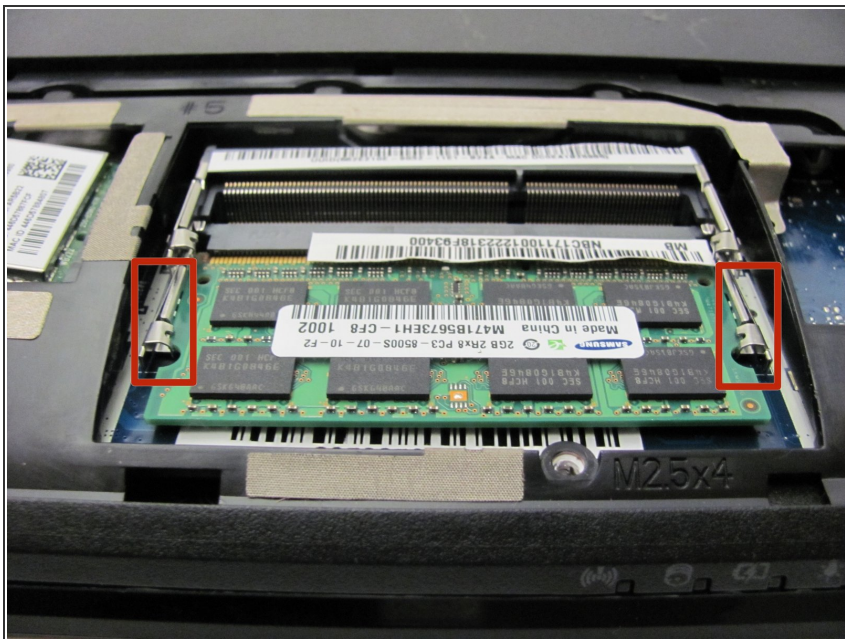
- Locate and remove the two 5.3 mm Phillips #1 screws holding the back panel in place.

Step 2



- Use a spudger to pry the panel up from the laptop case and remove it.
- The laptop should now be open with the RAM and wifi chip now accessible.

Step 3 — RAM



- Locate the two RAM clips.

Step 4



- Use two spudgers to pry the two clips outward to release the RAM chip.

Step 5



- Gently pull out the RAM chip.
- ❗ If your laptop is using more than one stick of RAM, remove the second by repeating the past three steps.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
