


# Sony Xperia U Headphone Jack Replacement


#### **INTRODUCTION**

If your phone's earphone jack is not working properly, follow these steps to assist you in replacing the headphone jack.



iFixit Opening Tool (1) Tweezers (1)

#### Step 1 — Battery



- Set the phone screen down on a clean flat, surface.
- Insert the plastic opening tool into the groove located between the body of the phone, and the back plate protecting the battery.
- Open the back of the device by prying around the sides of the back panel using the plastic opening tool.

#### Step 2



- Insert the plastic opening tool in between the battery and the phone body.
- Pry up on the side of battery, and remove it.

### Step 3 — Headphone Jack



- Insert the plastic opening tool in between the white plastic cover, and the body of the phone.
- Pop the plastic cover off. To do this, gently push forward on the plastic opening tool while it is in between the cover and the phone.

# Step 4



• Remove the six size 0 Phillips screws.

## Step 5



- Insert the plastic opening tool in between the body of the phone and the thin plastic back cover.
- Lift the black back cover off of the body with the plastic tool.

# Step 6



- Locate the earphone jack on the top left of the black plastic back cover.
- Use the <u>tweezers</u> to pinch the earphone jack and remove it from the back cover.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
