Step 1 — Rear Case



- Insert a fingernail or plastic opening tool into the divot to the left of the rear-facing camera.
- Gently pry and twist the flexible rear cover off the back of the phone.

Step 2 — Rear Facing Camera Lens



• Use a pair of tweezers to pry off the rear-facing camera ring.

(i) You may need to use the tweezers to run along the sides of the camera ring to loosen it.

Step 3



• Use a pair of tweezers to peel off the camera ring adhesive.

Step 4



- Gently slide one tip of a pair of tweezers underneath the rear-facing camera lens.
- Pry upwards with the tweezers and remove the camera lens.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
