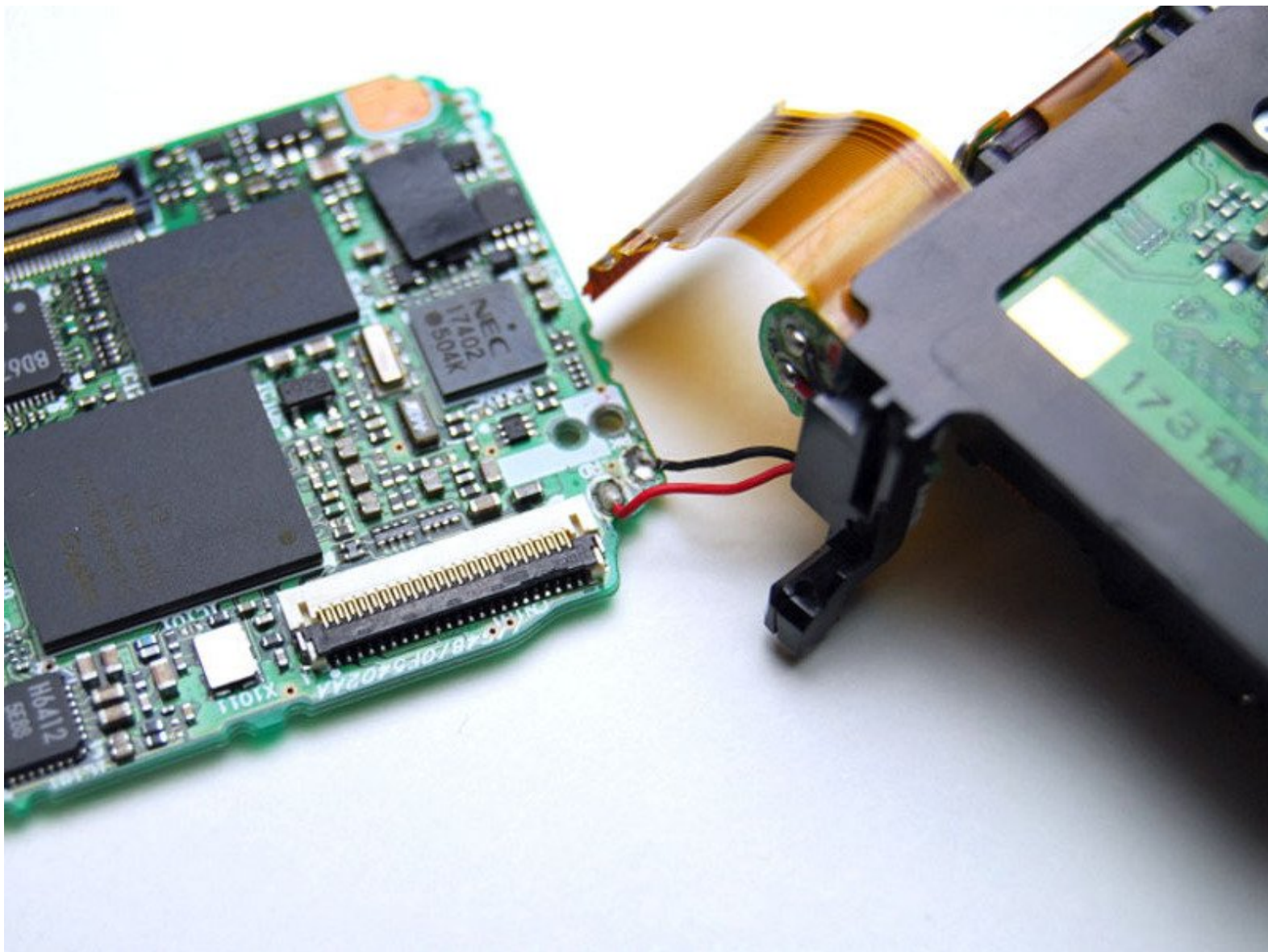

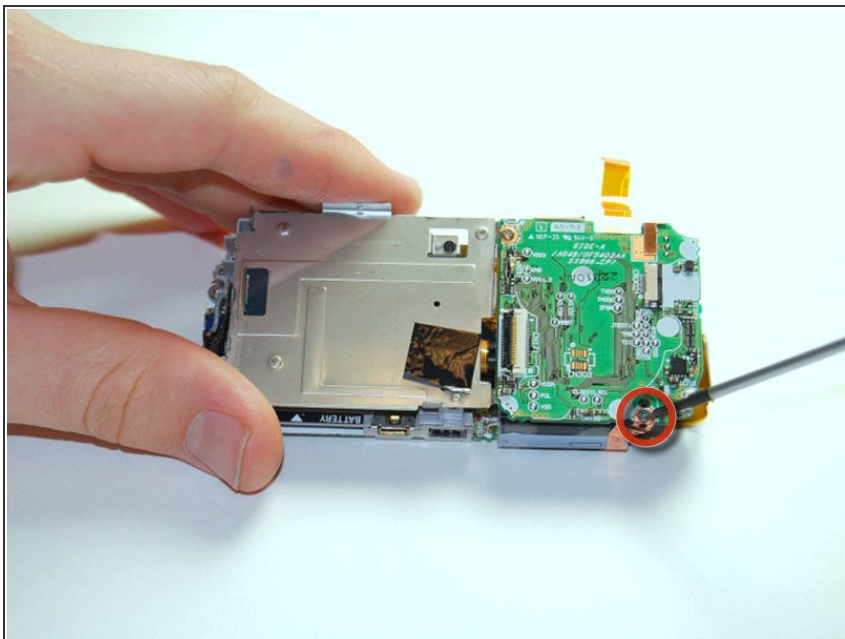

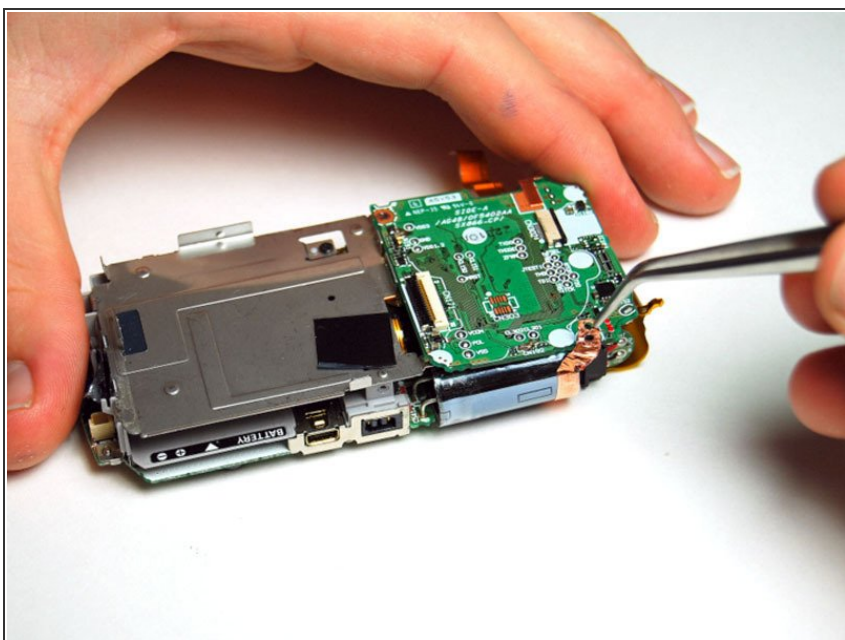
## Step 1 — Motherboard and Flash Unit



- Remove the 4 mm black screw on the bottom right corner of the motherboard.

ⓘ The black screw may be hard to remove. Use the tweezers if necessary.

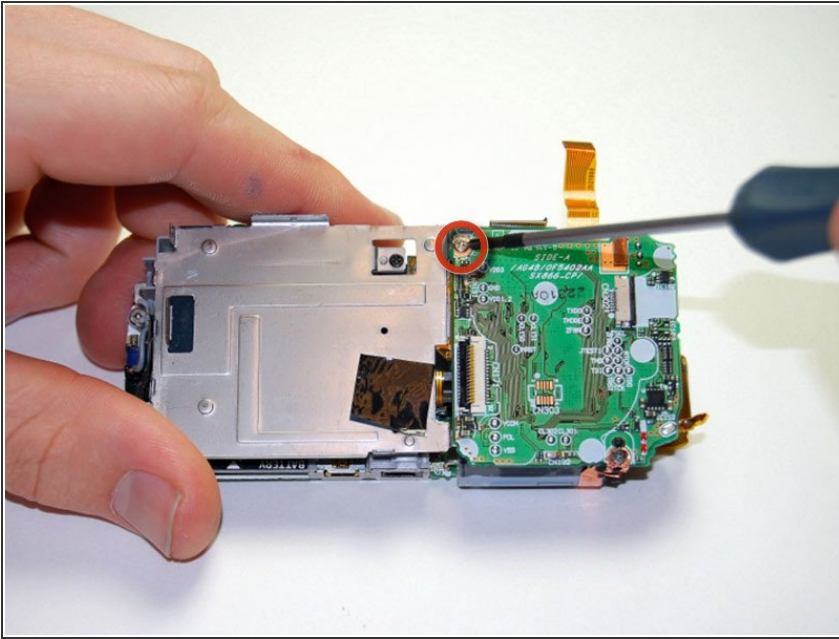
## Step 2



- With the tweezers, carefully peel back the copper ribbon that was underneath the black screw.

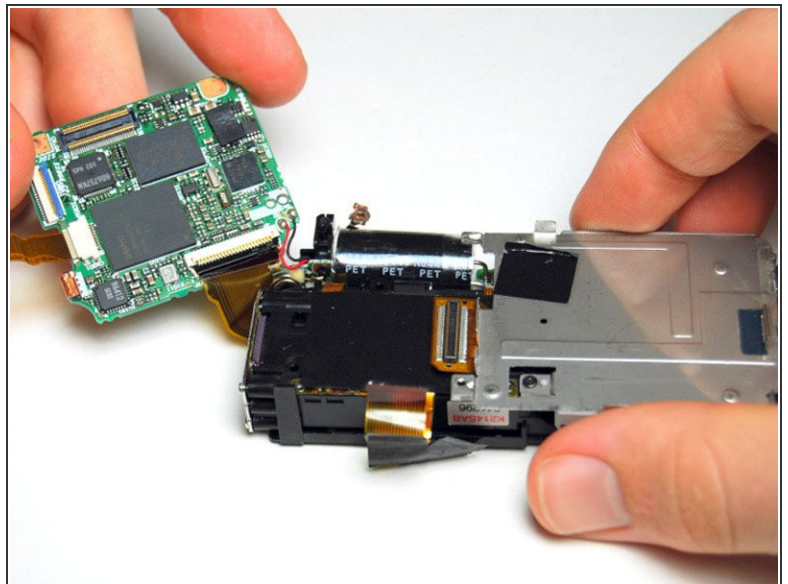
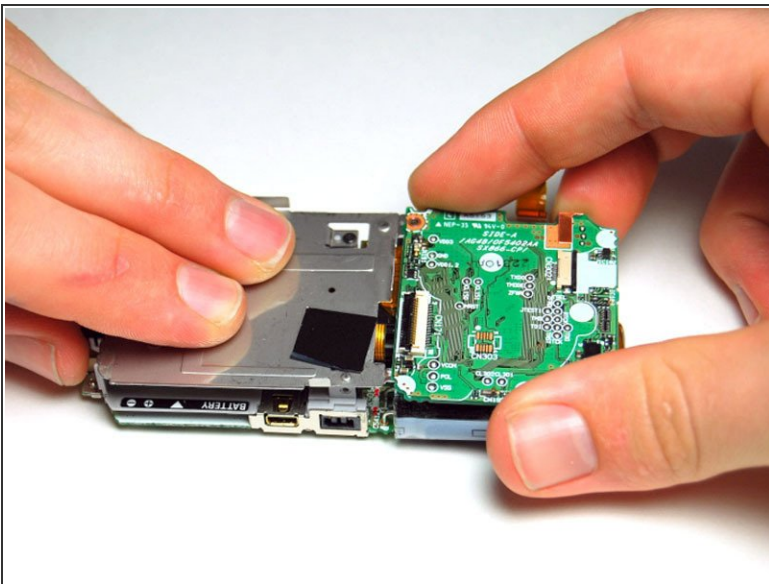


### Step 3



- Remove the 2.5 mm silver screw from the upper left corner of the motherboard.

### Step 4



- Press down on the metal plate and gently lift the motherboard up from left to right.

⚠ Be cautious when lifting the motherboard since there is a copper ribbon and two wires attaching the motherboard to the flash unit.

- Reorient the camera so you are looking at the top edge with the metal plate on the right.
