


Kodak S100 EF Flash Replacement

This will instruct the repair of the flash for the Kodak S100 EF.

INTRODUCTION

To start, the Front Cover Teardown guide must be used. Later, soldering guides will be used.



TOOLS:


- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Soldering Workstation (1)

Step 1 — Front Cover



- i Have the camera facing upwards and the flash closest to you.
- Unscrew the two 6.2 mm Phillips screws on the top half of the camera.

Step 2



- Flip the camera over to the other side-with flash farthest from you.
- Unscrew top two 6.2mm Phillips screws on this side.

Step 3



- i Turn the camera so the bottom is facing up with the front-facing away.
 - Unscrew the 6.2mm Phillips screw on the top right.
- The front cover is now unscrewed and should be lifted evenly and removed.

Step 4 — Flash



- Once the front cover is off, desolder the connections at both ends of the flash.
- If unfamiliar with soldering, refer to the guide <u>How To Solder and</u> <u>Desolder Connections</u>

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
