

# Olympus Camedia D560 Rear Panel Control Buttons Replacement

This guide demonstrates how to remove and either clean or replace the rear panel control buttons of the camera.

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#### **INTRODUCTION**

Step by step instructions to clean or replace the control buttons on the camera.



## **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

#### **Step 1 — Rear Panel Control Buttons**





- (i) Before disassembling your camera, be sure it is powered off.
- Remove two screws from the video port located at the side panel of the camera.
- Remove three screws from the bottom panel of the camera.

#### Step 2





- Open the USB port cover, and remove three screws from inside.
- Next, open the memory slot cover and remove the screw.

### Step 3








Use the blue opening tool to loosen and separate the back cover from the camera.

#### Step 4







- Locate and unscrew the three screws inside the back cover body (picture 3).
- Remove button pad assembly from the back cover.

#### Step 5







- (i) The button assembly is now separate from the back cover.
- Inspect for broken areas. Replace or clean the button parts.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
