INTRODUCTION

If the glass on the screen of your Samsung Galaxy Tab A 9.7 is cracked or damaged in any way, your device could be nearly unusable. This guide will help you replace the display glass in an easy and safe way.



TOOLS:

- iOpener (1)
- Metal Spudger (1)



PARTS:

Galaxy Tab A 9,7 Digitizer (1)

Step 1 — Display Glass



- Microwave the iOpener for 30 seconds.
- Place the iOpener on each side of the screen for 30 seconds.

Step 2



- Take a metal spudger and wedge it between the screen and the glass.
- Avoiding the screen itself, run the spudger along the perimeter of the device to weaken the glue between the glass and screen, and pry the glass off.

Step 3



- Using a suction cup, gently remove the screen from the device.
- When placing a new screen on the device, remember that you will have to reapply adhesive to the outside of the screen.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
